



Hunter Notice Advisory

2019-2020 Plainsboro Township Municipal Deer Management Program

Plainsboro Township will be accepting individual hunting permit applications for the Township's municipal deer management program to be conducted at the Plainsboro Preserve for the 2019-2020 hunting season to begin on September 14, 2019. The managed deer hunt is intended to reduce the deer population to minimize widespread vegetation damage to the Preserve and the surrounding environs.

All applicants must be 18 years or older (21 years or older if accompanied by a youth or apprentice license holder), have a valid New Jersey hunting license, and must show proof of and maintain \$1,000,000 general liability insurance for the entire hunting season. There is no application fee. Please note hunting permits are limited to a maximum of thirty (30) individuals. Upon notification, successful applicants are required to participate in a **mandatory** hunter orientation safety session scheduled for August 22, 2019 at 7pm at the Plainsboro Municipal Building (641 Plainsboro Road, Plainsboro, NJ). Hunting permits will be issued at the orientation session and will be valid for the entire 2019-2020 white tail deer hunting season. Failure to attend the mandatory orientation session will result in non-issuance of a permit.

The 2019-2020 deer management program kit, which includes a permit application form, a parcel location map, program rules, hunting schedule, the township resolution and ordinance and this advisory can be accessed on the main page of our website at www.plainsboronj.com Kits will also be available in the Township's Recreation and Cultural Center at 641 Plainsboro Road as of July 25, 2019. Applications must be received by the Plainsboro Police Department, 641 Plainsboro Road, Plainsboro, NJ 08536 no later than August 8, 2019. Please put completed application forms and all other documents in an envelope marked 'Plainsboro Preserve Deer Management Application'. Only fully completed applications will be processed. Any applicant who has violated any significant provision of the New Jersey Game Code N.J.A.C. 7:25-5 et seq. and N.J.S.A. Title 23 or has violated any local regulation pertaining to parks or to hunting within five years of the date of the application shall not be eligible for a permit. I have read, understand and **agree** to abide by the program rules and regulations set forth by Plainsboro Township.

Municipally Controlled Deer Management Program (Plainsboro Preserve only)

PROGRAM RULES AND REGULATIONS

2019-2020 Season

All state and local regulations pertaining to parks and to hunting (as established or amended by the New Jersey Division of Fish and Wildlife) apply, with additional unique season dates and a modified bag limit for harvesting white-tailed deer at the Plainsboro Preserve. See *Plainsboro Preserve Deer Management Program Schedule, attached*. Hunting shall occur **only** at the Plainsboro Preserve, 80 Scotts Corner Road, Plainsboro, NJ 08536. In addition, the following special rules apply:

Eligibility Requirements

Only licensed New Jersey hunters who meet the following criteria shall be eligible for a Plainsboro Preserve Deer Management Permit:

1. Must be 18 years of age or older. Must be 21 years or older if accompanied by a youth or apprentice license holder.
2. Are not prohibited by law from possessing a firearm.
3. Have not been convicted of a felony.
4. Have no significant New Jersey Fish and Wildlife violations or local parks violations within the past (5) years.
5. Can receive communications via email.
6. Will attend the mandatory hunter orientation on August 22, 2019 at 7:00pm in Community Room A/B of the Plainsboro Township Municipal Building.

Application Process - Notification

Printed copies of the Deer Management Program kit, which includes a permit application and other pertinent information, will be available beginning July 25, 2019, Monday – Friday, 9 am- 4 pm at the Plainsboro Township Recreation and Cultural Center, 641 Plainsboro Road, Plainsboro, NJ 08536.

1. Applications must be post marked or received by the Township no later than August 8, 2019.
2. For an application to be considered complete, the application form and all required attachments, as prescribed below, must be submitted.
3. Successful applicants that are selected by lottery will be notified through email by the Township on or around August 16, 2019.

Documentation Requirements

1. Applicants must include a copy of their current certificate of insurance confirming general liability insurance with combined single limits coverage for bodily injury and property damage of at least one million (\$1,000,000) dollars per single occurrence and one million (\$1,000,000) dollars annual aggregate, which can be satisfied through full membership in the New Jersey State Federation of Sportsmen's Clubs or other sources.
2. Permitted hunters must maintain this insurance for the entire hunting season. Hunters are responsible to renew the policy when due and may not hunt until proof of renewal is submitted to the Plainsboro Police Department.
3. Include a copy of each current, valid hunting license for the sporting arms to be used during each hunting season: Bow and Arrow, Firearm or All-Around Sportsman licenses.

Mandatory Hunter Orientation

Successful permit applicants are **required** to complete the Township's hunter orientation session scheduled for August 22, 2019 in Community Room A/B of the Plainsboro Township Municipal Building. **Do not apply if you cannot attend**. Your hunting permit and parking permit will be issued at the end of the orientation session. No permit will be issued unless you complete this course.

Permits

1. There is no permit fee.
2. Permits are non-transferrable.
3. Each hunter's permit must be carried together with personal hunting license and presented upon request. Each parking permit must be displayed on the front left dashboard whenever the hunter is on the property.

4. The permit authorizes **only** hunters to be on the Plainsboro Preserve property - 80 Scotts Corner Road, Plainsboro, New Jersey - for the management of white-tailed deer, including pre-season scouting, setting of bait (no feeders of any type) and while legally hunting or retrieving deer.

Vehicles and Parking

1. A Plainsboro Preserve parking permit will be issued after the mandatory hunter orientation.
2. Motorized vehicles are restricted to public roads and designated parking areas. The white trail can be used for deer pickup only, not for general parking.
3. Park only in designated parking areas or as directed by Plainsboro officials.
4. All-terrain vehicles are not allowed in the Plainsboro Preserve.

Tree stands

1. Hunting will be allowed from only commercially manufactured, portable tree stands. Hunting must take place from an elevated position to shoot down toward the ground.
2. Do not load, or raise, the sporting arm (gun or bow) until you are safely in your stand with a commercially manufactured fall-restraint device or harness functionally in-place.
3. Use a haul line on an unloaded firearm or uncocked bow to raise or lower the sporting arm from the ground to the tree stand and back.
4. Tree stands must be marked, visible from the ground, with the last two digits of the hunter's permit number.
5. Only one tree stand per hunter. If a portable stand or sling is used, the hunter may not have another stand on the property simultaneously.

Boundaries

1. A map of the Plainsboro Preserve is attached.
2. All property boundaries and safety zones must be respected, even where not marked.
3. Do not trespass on bordering properties, even to retrieve a deer, unless permission is granted by the landowner.
4. Obey all signs posted by Plainsboro Township and bordering landowners.

Hunting Restrictions - Methods

1. Only white-tailed deer may be hunted. The hunting, shooting, killing, pursuit or removal of any other wildlife is strictly prohibited.
2. Hunting days *are different* at the Plainsboro Preserve than for statewide hunting. See attached table for allowed dates.
3. No Sunday hunting on municipal property, as per state law.
4. Hunters may use only those sporting arms allowed by state law for each hunting season when open at the Plainsboro Preserve according to the attached schedule of hunting dates.
5. Hunters *must* always harvest two antlerless deer before harvesting an antlered deer. There is a harvest *maximum* of three antlered deer that applies throughout all seasons (September to February). A hunter *may* harvest all required antlerless deer "up front" if he/she chooses to. A harvest *minimum* of four antlerless deer is required with no *maximum* limit on the number of antlerless deer across all hunting seasons (September to February). Failure to harvest four antlerless deer during the season may disqualify the hunter from participating next season.
6. Target practice is strictly prohibited. Discharge of a crossbow prior to transporting is not considered target practice. A portable discharge target is recommended.
7. Violation of any special condition or any applicable State law or local regulation will result in the immediate loss of hunting privileges on the property and will also subject the hunter to any applicable penalties.

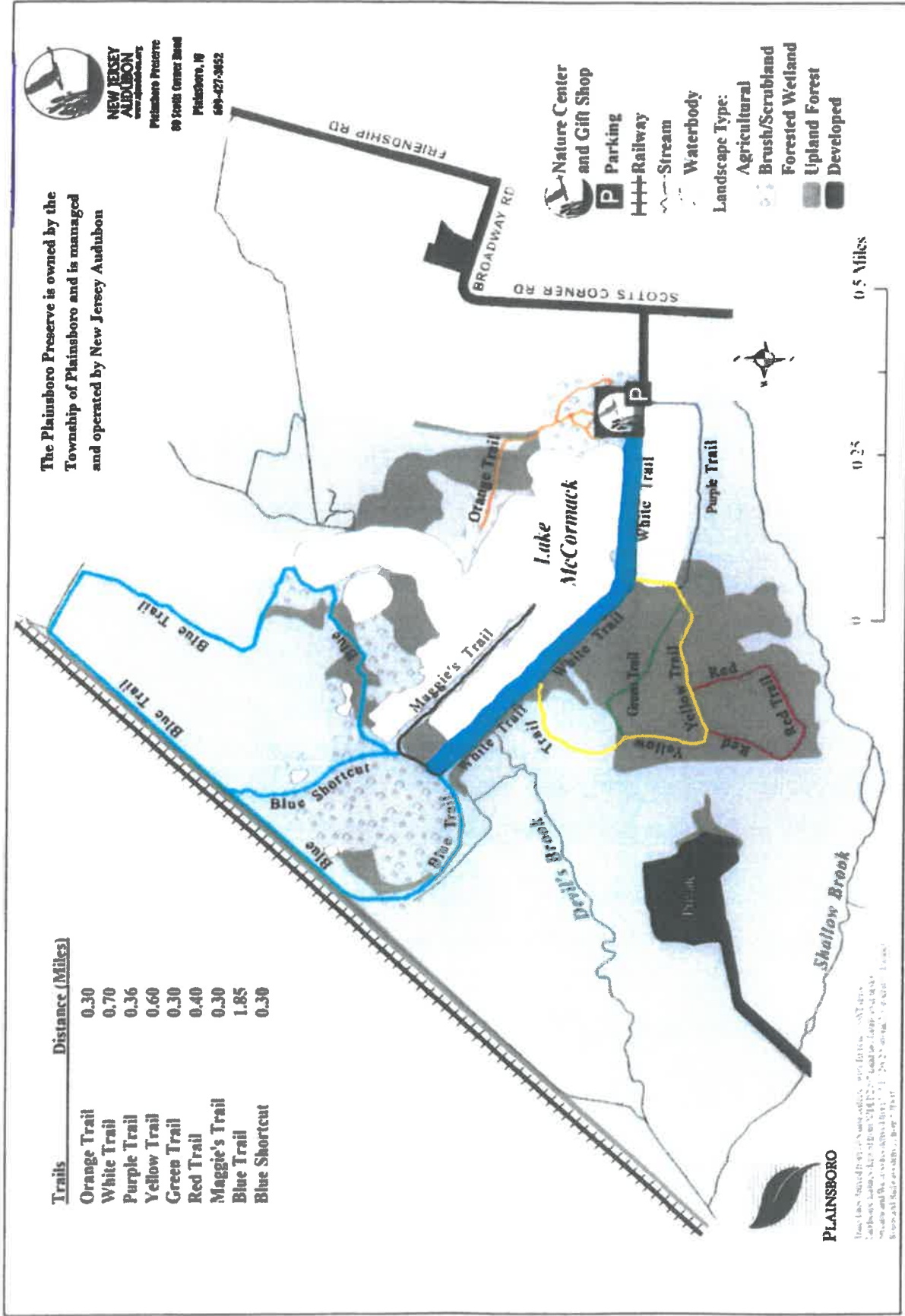
Reporting Your Harvest

1. Follow all state requirements to report your harvest and receive the state-issued Confirmation Number.
2. Complete your Plainsboro Hunter Report Log at the completion of each season: Fall Bow, Permit Bow, Permit Muzzleloader, Permit Shotgun and Winter Bow.

General Regulations

1. Littering is prohibited.
2. Use or possession of alcoholic beverages while on the property is prohibited.
3. The Plainsboro Preserve is a multi-use area. Respect other users' enjoyment of the land.
4. Violation of any special condition or any applicable State law or local regulation will result in the immediate loss of hunting privileges on the property and will also subject the hunter to any applicable penalties.

A RESOLUTION OPENING THE PLAINSBORO PRESERVE FOR DEER HUNTING DURING THE 2019-20 DEER HUNT SEASON AUTHORIZED BY THE STATE DIVISION OF FISH AND WILDLIFE

WHEREAS, the Township of Plainsboro adopted Ordinance 18-10, which authorizes the Township Committee to establish deer hunting seasons ; and

WHEREAS, the Committee finds that there is a compelling need to continue deer hunting season in 2019-2020, in accordance with the seasons established by the Division of Fish and Wildlife in the Department of Environmental Protection; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the governing body for the Township of Plainsboro has determined the Plainsboro Preserve shall be open for deer hunting, pursuant to Ordinance 18-10, as follows:

1. The deer hunting season shall be open in accordance with Regulation Set #8 promulgated by the New Jersey Division of Fish and Wildlife in the Department of Environmental Protection.
2. The application period shall begin July 25, 2019 and all applications must be post-marked and/or stamped 'received' by the Township no later than August 8, 2019.
3. For the 2019-2020 hunting season established by this resolution, a maximum of 30 permits shall be issued. There shall be no application fee for the 2019-2020 hunting season.
4. All hunting shall occur from mounted tree stands, which shall be constructed and removed at the sole cost of the permitted hunter.
5. Hunters *must* always harvest two antlerless deer before harvesting an antlered deer. There is a harvest *maximum* of three antlered deer that applies throughout all seasons (September to February). A hunter *may* harvest all required antlerless deer "up front" if he/she chooses to. A harvest *minimum* of four antlerless deer is required with no *maximum* limit on the number of antlerless deer across all hunting seasons (September to February). Failure to harvest four antlerless deer during the season may disqualify the hunter from participating next season.
