CURBSIDE BRUSH PICKUP

Curbside brush pickup is offered as an alternate monthly service March 1st through October 13th. Brush must be at curbside by 7am the first Monday of the month. Do NOT leave brush at curbside other than those pickup dates. Trimmings from trees, shrubs and vines only are accepted. Maximum length is six feet. NO ROOTS, STUMPS, SOIL or GRASS. Please stack branches neatly between the sidewalk and curb with limb ends in the same direction. DO NOT PLACE BRUSH IN STREET. Trimmings may also be dropped off at the Conservation Drop Off Center. PLEASE NOTE:

- BRUSH SHOULD BE LEFT AT THE CURB ON THE FIRST MONDAY OF THE MONTH DESIGNATED FOR YOUR STREET ONLY.
- BRUSH PLACED CURBSIDE DURING NON-SCHEDULED MONTHS COULD RESULT IN FINES AND CLEAN-UP COSTS.

OTHER SERVICES

Herbicide Spraying: All Plainsboro parks will be sprayed for weed control between April 17th and 21st (weather permitting). Notices will be posted at the Municipal Complex and will appear in local newspapers. Call Public Works at 799-0099 for details and exact schedule. Please note that park areas should not be used for 24 hours after spraying. Warning flags will be posted at the sites.
