Current Needs—October 2009

This list represents current food pantry needs for the month. It is updated monthly, so please check the website frequently to see what items are needed most.

Please note that we DO NOT accept non-food items (except those listed below), dairy, fresh produce, or meat, oversized items that cannot be easily divided among individual families, or items with dates that have passed/expired.

Grocery Items Needed

Applesauce and canned fruits
Breadcrumbs
Boxed meals/meal starters (e.g., Shake'n'Bake, Hamburger Helper, taco kits)
Cake/bread/muffin mixes and frosting
Cereal, dry (cold or hot)
Coffee/tea/coffee creamer
Condiments – ketchup, mustard, dressings, vinegar, oil, olives, relish, BBQ sauce, pickles
Cookies, crackers, popcorn, other sugar-free and low-/no-salt snacks
Diapers— sizes 4,5,6
Flour—white or wheat
Gravy
Infant formula— lactose-free
Jello / pudding mix , boxed or shelf-stable
Juice
Mayonnaise
Meats—canned (chicken, turkey, ham, tuna)
Milk – whole, evaporated or condensed; canned, dry, or shelf-stable

Nuts, salt-free or low-salt
Oatmeal / Cream of Wheat
Pancake mix and syrup
Pasta Mixes (PastaSides, PastaRoni)
Peanut butter and jelly
Potatoes – instant and canned
Powdered drink mixes
Rice and boxed rice mixes
Salad dressings
Stuffing
Sugar/honey/sugar substitutes
Tomato/pasta sauce

Personal Care Items Needed

Body lotion
Deodorant
Disposable razors
Sanitary pads / tampons
Shampoo and conditioner
Soap
Toothpaste
