FROM ROUTE 1


Take the Scudders Mill Road exit. Follow to the fifth traffic light (Dey Road). Make left onto Dey Road. Head east about 1.5 miles to Scotts Corner Road. Turn left onto Scotts Corner. Follow for about 1/4 mile past the Community Park on the left. The Preserve entrance will be on the left.

FROM NJ TURNPIKE

Take Exit 8A. Cross over Route 130. Follow Friendship Road. Friendship Road will end at the T-Intersection at Broadway. At the yield sign, make a right onto Broadway. Follow the curve as Broadway turns into Scotts Corner. The Preserve will be on your right.

FROM ROUTE 130

Take Friendship Road exit. Follow Friendship Road, making right at the yield sign at the T-intersection with Broadway. Follow bend as Broadway turns into Scotts Corner. Preserve entrance will be on the right.

Pricing and Add-on Options

\$250 (resident)/\$300 (nonresident) for up to 20 children (includes a one-hour themed educational program, one hour for your party time, 30 minutes for set up, and 30 minutes for clean up)

Add extra children for \$15 per child (up to a party maximum of 30 children)

Add an extra half hour of party time for an additional \$50

Additional Information

General Rules

The space used must be returned to its original condition before your group leaves the site. All food and party items must remain inside of the party area. The following items are not permitted: balloons, wall decorations, sticky hands, glitter, confetti.

Safety

Parking is permitted in designated areas only. Party attendees must comply with Plainsboro Preserve limitations. No smoking, no alcohol, and no pets are permitted. A list of all Preserve regulations can be found on the Plainsboro Township website. Party hosts are required to provide supervision of all attendees, and are responsible for the behavior of their guests at all times. All guests must wear appropriate clothing and footwear for the season (no open-toed shoes).
