

Schedule Your Troop's Program

Booking Information:

Scout Programs typically run on the weekends, with some weekday availability depending on the season. Please contact us to book your program at least a month in advance, and provide several date and time options.

Program Pricing:

- Cost is \$100 for up to 10 Scouts, and an additional \$10 per Scout up to a group maximum of 20 Scouts
- No cost for adult leaders/chaperones with a maximum of 3 chaperones per group
- If your group has needs that fall outside of these parameters, let us know. We will do our best to accommodate special programming requests.
- A \$50 deposit is required to hold your reservation. The remainder of your balance is due the day of your program. (Deposits are non-refundable within 14 days of your scheduled program).
- Make checks payable to: Township of Plainsboro (on the 'Memo' line write: Preserve Scout Program).

Program Details:

Programs are 90 minutes in length and take place at the Plainsboro Preserve (unless otherwise specified); some programs are seasonal in nature programs contain outdoor components — please ensure all participants wear appropriate clothing and footwear for the weather and season (no open-toed shoes).

FROM ROUTE 1


Take the Scudders Mill Road exit. Follow to the fifth traffic light (Dey Road). Make left onto Dey Road. Head east about 1.5 miles to Scotts Corner Road. Turn left onto Scotts Corner. Follow for about 1/4 mile past the Community Park on the left. The Preserve entrance will be on the left.

FROM NJ TURNPIKE

Take Exit 8A. Turn left at the light onto Cranbury South River Road. Exit right onto Forsgate Drive. After 2nd traffic light, cross over Route 130 and continue onto Friendship Road. Friendship Road will end at the T-intersection at Broadway. At the yield sign, make a right onto Broadway. Follow the curve as Broadway turns into Scotts Corner. The Preserve will be on your right.

FROM ROUTE 130

Take Friendship Road exit. Follow Friendship Road, making right at the yield sign at the T-intersection with Broadway. Follow bend as Broadway turns into Scotts Corner. Preserve entrance will be on the right.
