Traffic Advisory - Anticipate Increased Congestion Due to County Bridge Construction

Plainboro Township residents and commuters are advised to anticipate significant traffic congestion in the area of **Grovers Mill Road** affected by construction, due to an ongoing bridge construction project being managed by the Mercer County Department of Transportation.

This critical infrastructure project, located at the bridge over the Millstone River on **Grovers Mill Road**, involves replacement and is expected to continue **well into the upcoming school year**.

Motorists should be aware of traffic delays, lane closures, and altered traffic patterns in the vicinity of the construction zone. The increased congestion is particularly anticipated during peak commuting hours and especially during school drop-off and pick-up times once the academic year commences.

We strongly advise the following:

- **Plan Ahead:** Allow for extra travel time when commuting through the affected area.
- **Seek Alternate Routes:** Consider using alternative routes, if possible, to avoid the construction zone as *Grover's Mill Road into West Windsor will be closed*.
- **Exercise Patience:** Be patient and courteous to other drivers and construction crews.
- **Obey Signage:** Pay close attention to all posted traffic signs, detours, and flagger instructions.
- **School Commutes:** Families with children attending schools in or near the affected area should plan their routes and departure times accordingly, anticipating potential delays.
- **School Transportation:** Utilize school transportation to decrease traffic congestion.

The Plainboro Police Department will monitor traffic flow and adjust resources as needed to mitigate congestion and ensure safety. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation as the Mercer County Department of Transportation works to improve the safety of regional infrastructure.
