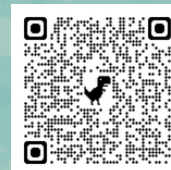
Winter Break Fun!: Eyes of the Wild Animal Show

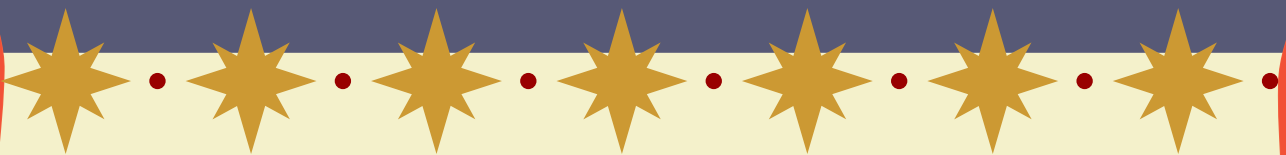

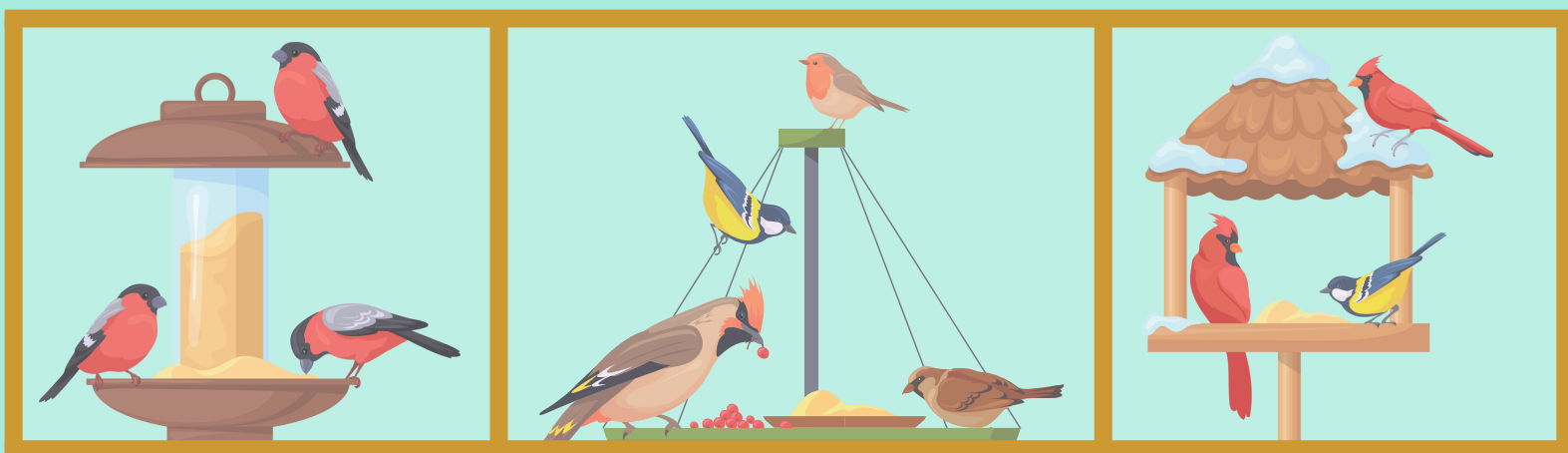
Adults' Nature Photography Meetup: Sunset Session

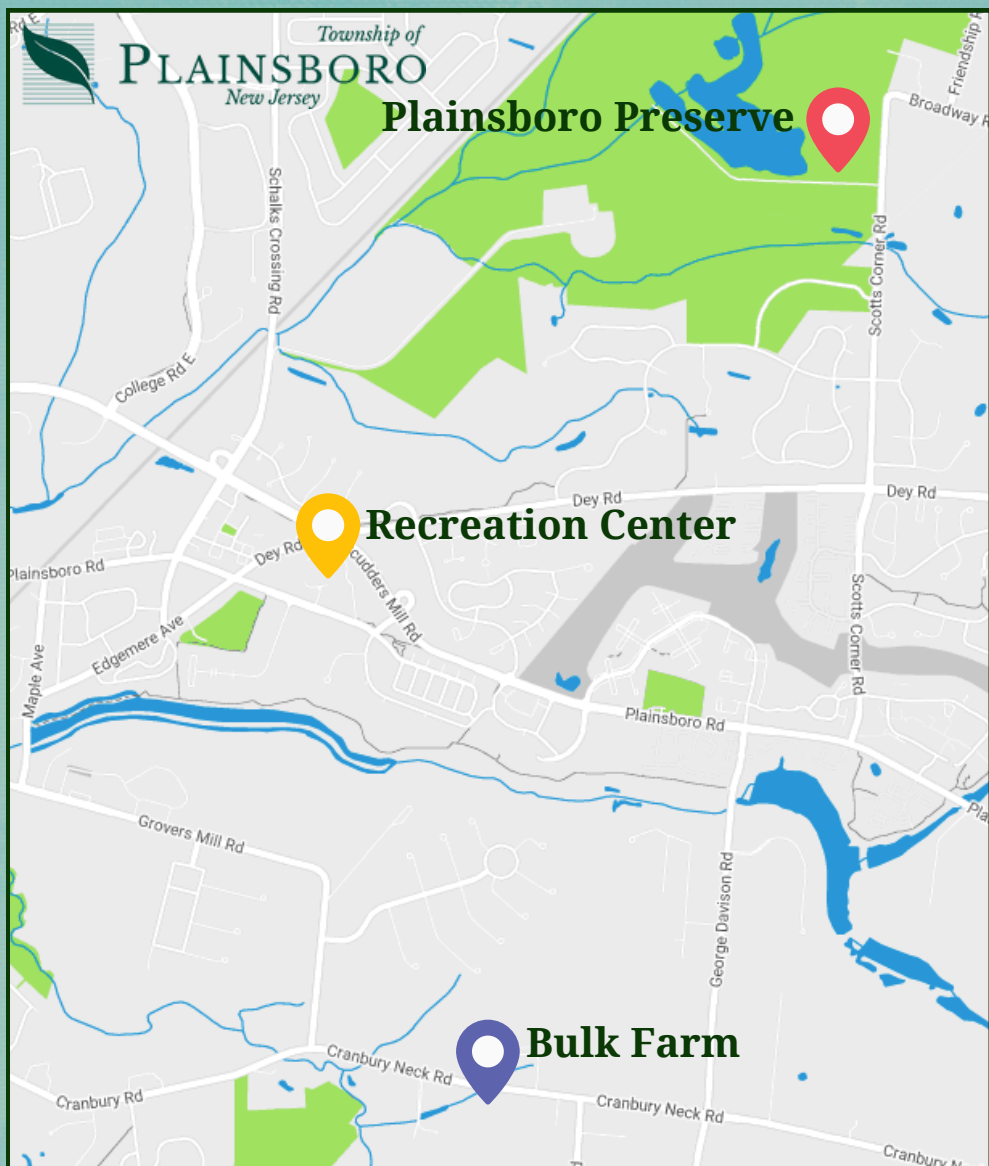
Dancing & Dessert
